Dear Parents and Employees:

This informational letter comes to you at the direction of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The agency requires all schools to inspect their buildings and facilities and to identify, sample, and analyze all friable and non-friable building materials that may contain asbestos. Friable materials are defined as those that can be easily crumbled by hand. The Asbestos in Schools Rule and the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) regulations further require that all parents and employees of schools where asbestos is found be notified. This requirement is a part of an inspection and management plan that is on file at your school.

The Clay County Board of Education has conducted an inspection of our entire school facilities. Any friable asbestos containing material that has been found to be damaged has been repaired or removed in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the United States Environmental Protection Agency. An extensive survey was completed to ensure that all of the Clay County School areas are safe and free of asbestos fibers.
